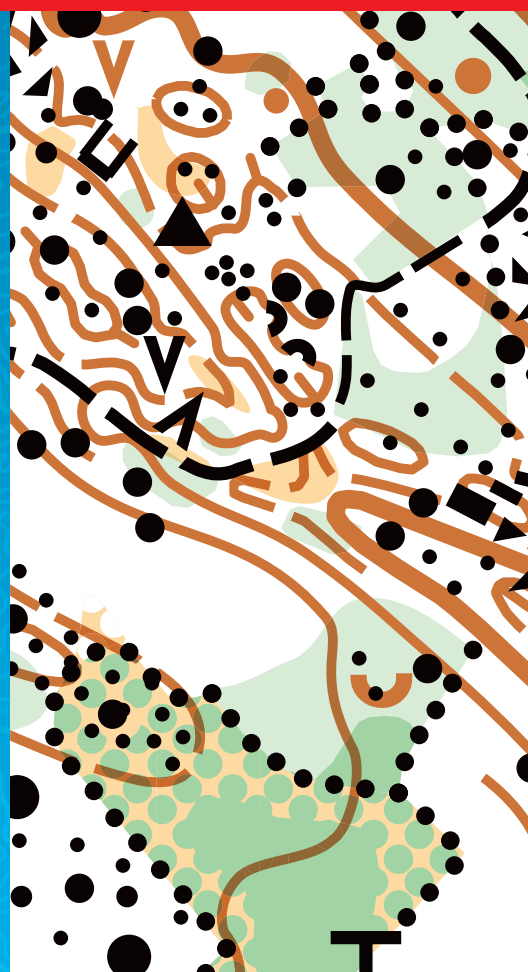

The organisers reserve the right to combine classes where there are only a small number of registered runners.

HDR – class for parents with children, line

T1 – class of very low level of difficulty, suitable for beginners and children (2-3 km)

T2 – class of middle level of difficulty (3-5 km)

T3 – class of higher level of difficulty (5-8 km)

In the class HDR and in the classes T, registration is also possible for individual stages one day in advance. Runners choose their own start times (also for Stage 6), and

the stage results are not combined (each stage has separate results). The lengths of the courses will differ for each stage – the shortest will be stage 5 (Sprint) and the longest stage 1 (Long Distance). The approximate lengths are in parentheses, see above (except for the sprint).

Participants from outside the Czech Republic can freely choose between A and B sub-classes (or A, B, C and E in D/H 21 respectively). The technical difficulty of the B sub-class is not significantly lower than in the A sub-class; the difference above all is in length.

Registration

Runners should register on the website www.jwoctour.cz/entries. If (really) necessary, email entries@jwoctour.cz can be used too. In each registration there can be runners from only one sports club. The payments must also be made separately for each sports club. Registration is accepted only after the organisers' approval. Fees and deadlines are stated in the table under.

* Registration for a single stage is only allowed for runners in class T.

Runners registered for all 6 stages on or before February 28, 2013 will receive the JWOC sports dress (a running T-shirt) for free (except for the T class).

The date of receipt of the registration determines.

Runners registered up to June 7, 2013 can order the sports dress using the registration system for 300 CZK. Runners in class T can order the sport dress using the registration system for 500 CZK. The dress will only be available until all stock is sold.

After June 7 it is only possible to register if there are still free start slots in the relevant classes (the number of runners in each class will be stated in the registration system).

The price in this case is 1200 CZK.

In the 'notice' field, please write the identification number, which you will receive in the confirmation e-mail after making your entry in the entry system. The payer bears all fees connected with the payment.

The payment must be made within 14 days of the date of submission of the registration. Otherwise the registration will not be accepted.

Competition areas

Distances from the Event Centre: Stage 1, Stage 3: 70 km.
Stage 2: 0 km. Stage 4: 35 km. Stage 5, Stage 6: 10 km.

Terrain

Stage 1 – pre-alpine moderately hilly to hilly terrain form consisting of several ridges and valleys, 450-650 m above sea level (asl.). Very good runnability, mostly coniferous forest, developed irregular network of forest roads and paths, 2nd World War fortification objects.

Stage 2 – recreational forest with a regular network of forest roads and paths, overall flat with many vegetation details.

Stage 3 – pre-alpine forest, both broadleaved and coniferous, with stony slopes, (550-710 m asl.), crowned by cliffs up to 10 m high. Plenty of boulders up to 5 m high, uneven ground, runnability in places significantly limited by stony ground, sparse network of paths, variable density of vegetation.

Stage 4 – pre-alpine forest, both broadleaved and coniferous, with stony slopes, plenty of boulders up to 5 m high, uneven ground, runnability in places significantly limited by stony ground, sparse network of paths, variable density of vegetation.

Stage 5 – historical city centre with irregularly developed network of roads, housing development with arcades, terraces with walls, or yards inside the housing blocks, and partly park area with a lot of roads, grass, flower beds and hedges.

Stage 6 – terrain is overall flat with some gentle slopes (260-290 m asl.), a regular network of forest roads and paths, many vegetation details. Runnability varies from excellent to poor.

Transport and parking

Car parks will be up to 500m from the arenas. It is also possible to use the organised bus transport from the Event Centre to the arenas. The transportation time is 75 minutes (Stage 1 and 3), 50 minutes (Stage 4) and 20 minutes (Stage 6). The transport and parking fees are stated in the fee table above.

Punching

The SportIdent punching system will be used. Runners with their own SI cards are asked to provide their SI card number on the registration form. SI cards can also be hired from the organisers.

Results

For Stage 1- Stage 5, only the winners will receive awards. For Stage 6 it will be the first 3 in the total ratings. From a runner's best 4 results from stages 1 to 5, the ranking for the handicap start in Stage 6 will be determined. The total ratings will be according to the finish order and the cumulative times after Stage 6.

Training

Training areas will be available from June 29 to July 1, 2013 close to the Event Centre. Training maps will be available at accreditation.

Accreditation

One person representing each registration needs to attend for accreditation at one of the following times:
29th June, 14:00-21:00 in the office in the Event Centre,
30th June, 9:00-21:00 in the office in the Event Centre,
and 1st July, 9:00-11:00 in the Stage 1 arena.

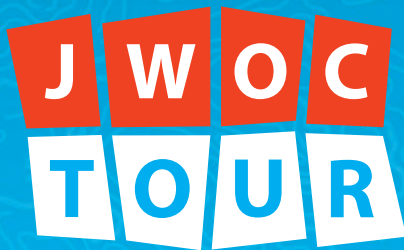
